JOUETT began the month of January with an inport period in Subic Bay. From 18 to 23 January, JOUETT was at sea involved in refueling with the USNS PASSUMPSIC, ECC/DC Drills and a Crossing the Equator Ceremony. On 23 January, JOUETT arrived in Sembaweng Naval Basin, Singapore. The month concluded with Captain Donald Martin relieving Captain William Poling as JOUETT's Commanding Officer.

Except for a one day inport period in Subic Bay, JOUETT spent the entire month of February at sea. During this period a series of Helicopter Operations were conducted. Major exercises included a MISSILEX, READEX, and Friendship I.

In the beginning of March, JOUETT was still at sea engaged in serving as Plane Guard for the USS KITTY HAWK. On 3 March JOUETT returned to Subic Bay for supplies and fuel. From 6 to 17 March JOUETT was detached from TG77-4 and proceeded to Guam with the USS ENGLAND, arriving in Guam on March 21st. From 22 to 31 March, JOUETT was in transit to Pearl Harbor, Hawaii. During this time Maneuvering Drills, a Missile Shoot, and a Synthetic AAWEX were conducted.

In Pearl Harbor JOUETT welcomed aboard a group of male relations of crew members who would transit back to San Diego as part of the Tiger Cruise Program. JOUETT left Pearl Harbor in transit to San Diego on 01 April. During this period Fan Firing, General Quarters, Tactical Maneuvering, and Synthetic AAWEX were conducted. On April 7th JOUETT moored at the Naval Station in San Diego, thus completing a seven month WESTPAC deployment. For the rest of April and most of May, JOUETT remained inport San Diego.

On 26 May JOUETT was underway for Sea Trials. On 31 May after a short inport period, JOUETT was underway involved in a series of operations, plus a port visit to Vancouver, British Columbia. From 31 May until 8 June, JOUETT took part in a series of Helicopter Operations, ECC Drills, and a READIEX exercise. JOUETT visited Vancouver from 8 June until 13 June, when the ship was again underway continuing a READIEX 3-78 War at Sea exercise. The exercise concluded on 17 June when JOUETT moored in San Diego.

On 19 June JOUETT left San Diego for the Naval Gun Fire Support Range on San Clemente Island. On 21 June JOUETT participated in Missile Firing on the Pacific Missile Range. JOUETT returned to San Diego on 22 June and had a very successful and well attended Dependents Cruise on 23 June. The month concluded with JOUETT inport San Diego.

During the months of July and August JOUETT was inport San Diego for extended availability. 13 through 16 September JOUETT was in an underway period which included an UNREP (Underway Replenishment) with the USNS TALUGA. The month concluded with JOUETT inport San Diego.

From 2 October until 7 October, JOUETT was at sea involved in Anti-Air Gunnery Exercises, Anti-Submarine Warfare Operations, and a refueling from USS WICHITA. On 10 October JOUETT was underway for the Naval Weapons Station at Seal Beach and then enroute for San Francisco where JOUETT was to be Visit Ship from 14-16 October. Beginning 17 October

JOUETT was underway for San Diego during which time the ship was involved in a War at Sea Exercise. 21-22 October JOUETT was inport San Diego. The month ended with an underway period for Mobile Training Team Phase II and an Anti-Air Warfare Exercise.

November began with an inport period in San Diego. During this time JOUETT sponsored a day at the San Diego Charger Football Game which produced a heavy turnout of JOUETT personnel and their dependents. The Naval Regional Librarian also visited the ship to help update the quantity and quality of books and other publications in the ships library. From 20 to 22 November JOUETT was at sea involved in a Synthetic Anti-Submarine Warfare Exercise, ECC Drills, and an Anti-Air Warfare Exercise with Fleet Training Command Pacific. The month ended with JOUETT inport San Diego.

From 3 to 8 December JOUETT was underway for SOCAL OPAREAS (Southern California Operating Area). The ship was involved in Helicopter Operations, a Synthetic AAWEX, and a refueling from USNS TALUGA. On 8 December JOUETT returned to San Diego. On 17 December JOUETT hosted a Christmas Dinner and Dance at the Hilton Hotel. On 20 December JOUETT hosted a Children's Christmas Party on board the ship. The month ended with JOUETT inport San Diego.
